

COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS
CLOUD COUNTY, KANSAS
AUGUST 15, 2022
UNOFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Regular session of the August meetings of the Cloud County Board of Commissioners was called to order at 9:00 a.m. on August 15, 2022 in the Commissioners' room at 811 Washington, Concordia, Kansas with Chairman Ron Copple, Members Bill Czapanskiy and Gary Caspers, and County Clerk Shella Thoman present.

County staff attending was: Andy Asch, Highway Administrator; Mike Hake, Solid Waste Director; and Dawn Snyder, Community Corrections / JJA Assistant Director.

Others attending: Toby Nosker, KNCK;

Andy Asch, Highway Administrator reported mediation was scheduled for September 19th with Coughlin Company regarding the Ames/ Miltonvale road. Discussed using hospital debris for refilling the Miller pit, truck prices and changing the bereavement leave policy to include nieces and nephews. No decision was made.

Dawn Snyder, Community Corrections / JJA Assistant Director presented year end reports for approval.

On a motion by Commissioner Caspers, second by Commissioner Czapanskiy, unanimous vote the Board approved the Fiscal year 2022 Community Corrections Year End Outcome report.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved the Kansas Community Corrections Act Fiscal Year 2022 Quarterly Budget Adjustment report totaling \$23,242.49.

On a motion by Commissioner Caspers, second by Commissioner Czapanskiy, unanimous vote the Board approved the Kansas Department of Corrections – Division of Juvenile Services fiscal year 2022 Quarterly Budget Adjustment report totaling \$25,546.17.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved the fiscal year 2023 Adult Carryover Reimbursement Budget Summary totaling \$21,396.57.

On a motion by Commissioner Caspers, second by Commissioner Czapanskiy, unanimous vote the Board approved the fiscal year 2023 12th Judicial District Community Corrections/Juvenile Services Juvenile Carryover Reimbursement Budget Summary report totaling \$5,431.00.

Mike Hake, Solid Waste Director discussed the hospital debris and trailer issues and reported he was getting quotes for repairs to the Transfer Station roof. Sold 35,395 lbs. of cardboard at a \$135 a ton.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanaskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved the request for Capital Outlay Funds for the Maintenance Department in the amount of \$1,300 to replace out dated and failing air handler motors.
