COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS CLOUD COUNTY, KANSAS FEBRUARY 22, 2022 OFFICIAL PROCEEDINGS

Regular session of the February meetings of the Cloud County Board of Commissioners was called to order at 9:00 a.m. on February 22, 2021 in the Commissioners' room at 811 Washington, Concordia, Kansas with Chairman Ron Copple, Members Bill Czapanskiy and Gary Caspers, and County Clerk Shella Thoman present.

County staff attending was: Andy Asch, Highway Administrator; Jeff Thoman, Maintenance Manager; and Brandi Bray, Health Department Administrator.

Others attending: Toby Nosker, KNCK; and Wyatt Hoch, Foulston Siefken, LLP (virtually).

Wyatt Hoch, Foulston Siefken joined the meeting by Zoom.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved a 10-minute executive session with Wyatt Hoch, Foulston Siefken LLP for Client-Attorney privilege to discuss Law Enforcement Center repairs including County Clerk Shella Thoman and resuming open session at 9:18 a.m.

Jeff Thoman, Maintenance Manager presented a quote for repairs to the broken drain plug for \$2,198.00 and discussed removing the water fountain on the second floor. The Board agreed to remove the fountain.

Brandi Bray, Health Department Administrator reported she signed the purchase order for \$11,853 for new vaccine refrigerators. The IAP supplemental 3 grant funds will be used.

On a motion by Commissioner Caspers, second by Commissioner Czapanskiy, unanimous vote the Board approved the request for Capital Outlay funds for the Attorney's office in the amount of \$7,825.00 for a Sharp MX-3571 copier.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved the classification change for James Beam, Asphalt Foremen from \$17.30 to \$18.54 effective February 27, 2022.

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved an additional \$226.98 from the Get in the Cloud grants funds for Downtown Girls.

The Board approved the following payroll expenses totaling \$163,820.36

On a motion by Commissioner Czapanskiy, second by Commissioner Caspers, unanimous vote the Board approved the February 14, 2021 minutes as presented.

On a motion by Commissioner Caspers, second by Commissioner Czapanskiy, unanimous vote the Board adjourned at 10:58 a.m., until Monday February 28, 2022.
